The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 102c of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The Fruits of *Solanum aethiopicum*, originate in a place of production established by the national plant protection organization of Uganda in accordance with ISPM10 as a place of production that is free from *Keiferia lycopersicella* (Walsingham) on the basis of official inspections and surveys carried out during the last three months prior to export. 4. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 103c of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). Prior to the export of the fruits of *Solanum aethiopicum*, they have been officially inspected and found free from *Thrips palmi* Karny. 5.
