PERMIT TO EXPORT PLANT MATERIAL

(To be retained by Company Representative)

N.B: FOR EACH SHIPMENT, A COPY OF THIS PERMIT MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE PACKING FACILITY AND EXIT POINT AS AN ACCOMPANIMENT OF THIS PARTICULAR PRODUCE. IF THIS IS NOT PRESENTED, THIS PARTICULAR PRODUCE SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN OBTAINED FROM A FARM (PRODUCTION PLACE) THAT IS NOT-CERTIFIED BY THE NPPO; AND THUS, NOT PERMITTED FOR EXPORT.

Permission is hereby granted to INTERFRUIT DEMERS LTD of Najjanankubi of usasio kampala district (Exporter, Contacts and address) to Export from MUBANZA 21 TASED of Mityana, Kitamavu village (Farmer Name, Code, District, Village and GPS location) the following plants/seeds/plant parts:

Nature of Export: Fresh produce (Product and purpose)

Subject to the following conditions:

1. All plants/seeds/fruits/plant parts to be the produce of and grown by farmer herein
2. Weekly field/farm report submitted to NPPO by agronomist
3. Plants or plant parts must be free from Regulated and Regulated Non-Quarantine pests
4. Farm scouting done atleast five times per week (by the farmer); and documentation submitted to MAAIF-NPPO on weekly basis whether company is intending to export or not.
5. Each consignment shall be accompanied with relevant field documents as required by NPPO.

Fabrication/falsification of documentation shall lead to cancellation of the permit.

This permit is valid for one month from date of issue, but may be cancelled at any time by the NPPO.
