The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 95c of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of *Solanum aethiopicum* comply with the following conditions: (i) the plants have been produced in a production site which is registered and supervised by the national plant protection organisation of Uganda, (ii) official inspections have been carried out in the production site during the three months prior to export, and no presence of *Spodoptera frugiperda* (Smith) has been detected on the plants, and (iii) prior to their export, the plants have been subject to an official inspection. (iv) the production site is identified in the official statement for traceability purposes, and (v) the production site is provided with complete physical protection against the introduction of *Spodoptera frugiperda* (Smith). 2. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 101c of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of *Solanum aethiopicum* comply with the following conditions: (i) that they originate in a place of production established by the national plant protection organisation of Uganda in accordance with ISPM10 as a place of production that is free from *Neoleucinodes elegantalis* (Guenée), and (ii) that they are free from that pest as shown from official inspections carried out in the place of production at appropriate times during the growing season, which included an examination on representative samples of fruit, and (iii) which includes information on traceability 3. The consignment complies with Option (d) schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, under point 102B of the retained Great Britain's Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation (2019/2072): the fruits *Solanum aethiopicum* have been subjected to an effective systems approach to ensure freedom from *Bactrocera latifrons* (Hendel).
