2. Weekly field/farm report submitted to NPPO by agronomist
3. Plants or plant parts must entirely be free from Quarantine pests
4. Farm scouting done atleast five times per week; and documentation submitted to MAAIF-NPPO on weekly basis whether company is intending to export or not.
5. Each consignment shall be accompanied with relevant field documents as required by NPPO.

Fabrication/falsification of documentation shall lead to cancellation of the permit.

This permit is valid for one month from date of issue, but may be cancelled at any time by the Commissioner Crop Inspection and Certification or by the officer(s) issuing the permit on his behalf.
